



## **Nova Scotia Recreation Professionals in Health Student Leadership Award**

The NSRPH Student Leadership Award was developed in 2009 and is awarded to an NSCC Waterfront Campus student studying (graduating from) Therapeutic Recreation. Each year the NSCC provides the award recipient with a gift certificate from the book store, a certificate for their portfolio, as well as having the name plate engraved to be added to the big plaque which is displayed in the Health and Human services area at the Campus. Generally the President or another designate from the Board presents the award to the Recipient at the NSCC Award's Ceremony in June. Our contribution is free registration at that years Conference and AGM. Here is a bit more info about the criteria:

### **NSRPH Student Leadership Award**

The Nova Scotia Recreation Professionals in Health Student Leadership Award was developed to give recognition to a graduating Therapeutic Recreation Diploma student (NSCC Waterfront Campus) who shows leadership and commitment to NSRPH and the field of Therapeutic Recreation. The first award

was presented at the NSCC Waterfront Campus in June 2009. To apply for this award, you must submit one specific program plan of an innovative program idea with a cover letter indicating your name and contact information to the President of NSRPH by April 30th. Applications for the award will be reviewed at the May NSRPH Board of Directors meeting and a winner will be chosen. You must be a student in good standing enrolled in the Nova Scotia Community College Therapeutic Recreation Diploma program with an average of 75 or above. The Recipient will be presented with the award at the NSCC Award's Ceremony, and will include a plaque that will be displayed in the Human Services area of the NSCC. The student will also be awarded free Registration to that year's NSRPH Conference and AGM.
